Project Overview

The GGBA is building its volunteer program, the Ambassador Program, and is looking to engage two (2) individual contractors to act Coordinators of the Ambassador program.

These part-time, evening positions are ideal for budding LGBTQ entrepreneurs, community members looking to build their network, supplier diversity professionals, and gig economy workers seeking a fun, part-time engagement that provides a high value of return, including an annual GGBA membership, for a minimal time investment.

The Coordinators will help engage and manage GGBA event volunteers leading up to, and on onsite at, monthly Make Contact mixers in San Francisco, the East Bay, and special events such as GGBA's signature event, The Power Lunch.

Scope of Work

- Work with Membership and Event Committee leaders to engage with volunteers via email or phone leading up to the event
- Help with onsite set-up at monthly Make Contact mixers in San Francisco and the East Bay.
- Help oversee activity of volunteers during the event (registration, information, catering setup, speed networking)

- 3. LGBTBE Certification Status (if applicable)
- 4. Personal / Professional bio with specific, relevant experience
- 5. Three (3) references of current/past clients that would be relevant to this project.
- 6. Desired hourly rate, with any/all discounts provided given our 501c6 non-profit status.
